

Summer School Policy

Absences: Daily attendance is required for traditional classes. A student absent more than two days will be dismissed from Summer School.

Tardies: Two tardies equal one absence.

Classroom Behavior: Students are expected to be on time, prepared to work, respectful of the instructor and their peers at all times. The Stow Code of Student Behavior is in effect at all times during summer school. Referrals to the office jeopardize a student remaining in summer school. Fighting/threatening will result in an automatic expulsion from Summer School. Stow-Munroe Falls School District is a Smoke-Free District. Violation of this policy will result in expulsion from Summer School. Expulsion results in no fees being refunded; no credit earned. Students are permitted access to the Summer School classroom assigned and the Commons. Only students enrolled in Summer School Physical Education Courses are permitted in the gymnasium.

Dress Code: Appropriate school dress is required during Summer school. No bare midriffs, short shorts, tanks/halter tops, sunglasses or blankets are permitted. The Stow Code of Student Behavior is in effect with respect to the Summer School Dress Code.

Electronic Devices: Stow-Munroe Falls High School is a NO CELL PHONE high school. Students are not permitted to use electronic devices while in the school building. Students violating this policy will be expelled from Summer School.

Students are not permitted to leave school grounds during their assigned class schedule. Students are expected to leave school grounds immediately following the end of their assigned class.
