

DISTRICT MEDICATION POLICY

All prescription medications, including inhalers and homeopathic medications must be brought in to the school by a parent or guardian with a health care provider's order to administer and in the medication's original container. No medications of any kind will be accepted if put in a baggie or any other type of container.

All prescription medications must be accompanied by a health care provider's order to administer and parent signature. Non-prescription or over-the-counter medications must be accompanied by the Non-Prescription form filled out and signed by the parent or guardian. All medications must be brought to the school in the original container. Medications that may be carried by the student include:

Asthma inhalers

Epi-Pens

Diabetes equipment/insulin

These self-carry medications **must be accompanied by an order from the health care provider that the student is able and responsible to carry their own medication.**
